Petitioner, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, brings this petition for a writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254.

Petitioner has not filed a complete application to proceed in forma pauperis, along with a “certification from the warden or other appropriate officer of the place of confinement showing the amount of money or securities that the petitioner has in any account in the institution” as required by Rule 3(a)(2) of the Federal Rules Governing Section 2254 Cases, or paid the required filing fee. See 28 U.S.C. §§ 1914(a), 1915(a). In particular, the certification form attached to petitioner’s application is not signed by any prison official. Furthermore, while petitioner forwarded a letter to the court purporting to contain the \$5.00 filing fee for this case, no such fee was enclosed.
