9 02013 MCE-CKD be reassigned to Judge John A. Mendez and Magistrate
10 Judge Carolyn K. Delaney and for all further proceedings, and any
11 dates currently set in this reassigned case only are hereby
12 VACATED. Henceforth, the caption on documents filed in the
13 reassigned cases shall be shown as 2:13-CV-02013 JAM-CKD.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court make
15 appropriate adjustment in the assignment of civil cases to
16 compensate for this reassignment.

17 IT IS SO ORDERED.
