Due to the lack of coherence in 18 19 plaintiff's allegations, the court waived any filing fee. Since that date, plaintiff has filed a request 20 for settlement (ECF No. 11), a petition for writ of habeas corpus (ECF No. 12), another motion to 21 proceed in forma pauperis (ECF No. 13), and consent to proceed before the undersigned 22 magistrate judge (ECF No. 14.) These documents have been disregarded. Plaintiff now files a request for status. (ECF No. 15.) 23 24 Plaintiff is hereby informed that this case remains closed for the reasons stated in the court's order filed August 9, 2013. (ECF No. 9.) Any further documents filed in this action will 25 26 be disregarded; no further orders will issue in response to any future filings. Moreover, plaintiff

is admonished that failure to abide by this directive may result in the imposition of sanctions. See

may be grounds for imposition by the Court of any and all sanctions authorized by statute or Rule or within the inherent power of the Court."). If plaintiff has a bono fide claim to pursue, he must do so in a new action. For these reasons, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. This case remains closed. 2. Plaintiff is informed that further filings in this action may result in the imposition of sanctions. 3.
