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1 The factual and legal basis for this ruling includes the
2 following: (a) the Sealed Documents are private financial
3 documents of non-party borrowers that are prohibited from
4 disclosure by the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act, 15 U.S.C. § 6801 et
5 seq.; (b) it is the policy of Congress as reflected by the Gramm-
6 Leach-Bliley Act, 15 U.S.C. § 6801 et seq. to protect the
7 security and confidentiality of the private financial information
8 of the non-party borrowers; (c) countervailing interests in
9 protecting the Sealed Documents outweighs the public's interest
10 in access, and there is a significant interest in protecting the
11 Sealed Documents to help prevent the potential misuse of the
12 Sealed Documents; (c) compliance with Fed. R. Civ. P. 5.2 alone is
13 not sufficient to protect the totality of the nonpublic personal
14 financial information of the non-party borrowers whose identity
15 can be determined from publicly available documents, including
16 deeds of trust; (d) if the Sealed Documents were filed publicly,
17 they might become a vehicle for improper purposes such as
18 identity theft; and (e) it is the only effective mechanism to
19 protect the nonpublic personal information of the non-party
20 borrowers and prevent the Court's file from becoming a vehicle
21 for improper purposes.

22 The Sealed Documents are permanently sealed.
