The Court, having considered Plaintiff JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A. (JPMC or Plaintiff) and Defendant Sierra Pacific Mortgage Company, Inc.'s (Sierra or Defendant) Joint Stipulation of Dismissal with Prejudice, hereby grants same.

It is therefore ORDERED that all claims which were asserted between Plaintiff and Defendant related to the Loans identified as 1 through 4, 6, 7, and 9 through 14 in Exhibit B to the Complaint (Dkt No. 1) in this civil action are hereby dismissed with prejudice.
