25	In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:		
26	1. Petitioner's motion to proceed in forma pauperis (ECF No. 2) is granted.		
27	2. Petitioner's motion to stay this action (ECF No. 3) is granted. This action is stayed and		
28	the Clerk of the Court is directed to administratively close this case.

1	3. Within 30 days of exhaustion of state court remedies, petitioner shall either dismiss this	
2	action pursuant to Rule 41 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, indicate he is ready to proceed	
3	with the habeas petition already on file, or file a motion seeking leave to file an amended petition	
4	with the proposed amended petition.
