**ORDER RE: DEPOSIT INTO COURT
 REGISTRY**

1 Pursuant to Plaintiff Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation as Receiver for Butte
2 Community Bank (the "FDIC-R") and Defendants Robert Ching, *et al.*'s ("Defendants") Joint
3 Stipulation for Order Permitting Deposit to Court Registry (the "Stipulation"), it is HEREBY
4 ORDERED that Defendants may deposit with the registry of this Court \$2,813,499.47 (the
5 "Deposit").

6 The Deposit shall be held by the registry of the Court, and remain subject to General
7 Order 573, unless and until submission of a joint stipulation by the FDIC-R and Defendants for
8 disbursement, and/or upon issuance of further order from the Court as necessary to authorize any
9 disbursement of the Deposit pursuant to the terms of the Stipulation.

10 Pursuant to the Stipulation, the FDIC-R and Defendants shall file a new joint stipulation
11 for stay of execution of judgment within three (3) days of Defendants' Deposit.

12 By entering into the Stipulation, Plaintiff and Defendants reserve and do not waive any
13 right to appeal the Judgment, the Verdict, or any other order of this Court.
