**ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT'S
MOTION FOR RELIEF AND TO DEEM
DEFENDANTS' DESIGNATION OF
EXPERT WITNESSES AS TIMELY**

This matter is before the Court pursuant to Defendants County of Sacramento, Sheriff's Department; County of Sacramento; Sheriff Scott Jones; and Deputy Anthony Jenkins's (collectively "Defendants") Motion for Relief and to Deem Defendants' Designation of Expert Witnesses as Timely.
