ORDER

Petitioner is a federal prisoner proceeding without counsel. This action was opened as an application for a writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241.¹ On October 15, 2013, the court informed petitioner that to properly commence an action, she must file a proper application for a writ of habeas corpus as required by 28 U.S.C. § 2242, and must either pay the required filing fee or file an application requesting leave to proceed in forma pauperis. See 28 U.S.C. §§ 1914(a), 1915(a). The court granted petitioner thirty days within which to file the required documents. The court also warned petitioner that failure to so comply would result in a dismissal of this action.
