When Plaintiff failed to file 20 timely objections, the findings and recommendations were adopted in full and this action was 21 dismissed. Judgment was entered accordingly. Following the entry of judgment, Plaintiff filed a 22 motion for extension of time to file his objections. On review, Plaintiff's motion will be granted. 23 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 24 1. The Clerk of Court is directed to reopen this case; 25 2.
