 18 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by and between the parties through their undersigned  
 19 counsel, subject to the approval of the Court, that Plaintiff be awarded attorney fees under the

 21 CENT (\$4,599.02). This amount represents compensation for all legal services rendered on  
 22 behalf of Plaintiff, to date, by counsel in connection with this civil action, in accordance with 28  
 23 U.S.C. § 2412.
