17	On May 20, 2014, the magistrate judg	ge filed findings and recommendations herein which
18	were served on the parties and which contain	ed notice that any objections to the findings and
19	recommendations were to be filed within four	rteen days. No objections were filed.
20	Accordingly, the court presumes that	any findings of fact are correct. See Orand v.
21	<u>United States</u> , 602 F.2d 207, 208 (9th Cir. 19	79). The magistrate judge's conclusions of law are
22	reviewed de novo. See Britt v. Simi Valley U	Unified School Dist., 708 F.2d 452, 454 (9th Cir.
23	1983).	
24	The court has reviewed the applicable	e legal standards and, good cause appearing,
25	concludes that it is appropriate to adopt the P	roposed Findings and Recommendations in full.
26	Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that:	
27	1. The Proposed Findings and Recor	mmendations filed May 20, 2014, are ADOPTED.
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1	2. Defendants' motions to dismiss (ECF Nos. 8, 17, 18, 21, 33) is granted to the extent
2	outlined below.
3	3. Peter Walsh's claims pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (causes of action 1 and 2) are
4	dismissed <i>without</i> leave to amend as to all defendants.
5	4. Liliya Walsh's claims pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (causes of action 1 and 2) are
6	dismissed <i>without</i> leave to amend insofar as they are alleged against Rocklin Police Department.
7	5. Liliya Walsh's claims pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (causes of action 1 and 2) are
8	dismissed with leave to amend insofar as they are alleged against Sutter, Telecare and Placer
9	County.
10	6. Both plaintiffs' requests for punitive damages against defendants Rocklin Police
11	Department and Placer County are dismissed without leave to amend.
12	7. The following state-law causes of action are dismissed <i>without</i> leave to amend as to all
13	defendants insofar as they are alleged by Peter Walsh : false arrest/false imprisonment (claims 3
14	and 4), battery (claim 5), assault (claim 6), defamation (claim 9), medical malpractice (claim 11),
15	and the three causes of action for violations of the LPS Act (claims 10, 14, 15).
16	8. All state-law causes of action alleged by Peter Walsh against Rocklin Police
17	Department and Placer County are dismissed <i>without</i> leave to amend.
18	9. Peter Walsh's seventh (intentional infliction of emotional distress), eighth (negligent
19	infliction of emotional distress), and thirteenth ("misrepresentation") causes of action are
20	dismissed <i>with</i> leave to amend insofar as those claims are asserted against Sutter, Telecare and
21	AMR.
22	10. Both plaintiffs' twelfth cause of action for "conspiracy" are dismissed <i>without</i> leave
23	to amend with respect to all defendants insofar as plaintiffs allege the existence of a conspiracy
24	as a standalone cause of action.
25	11. Liliya Walsh's state-law claims against Placer County (causes of action 7, 8 10, 13,
26	14, 15) are dismissed <i>with leave to amend.</i>
27	12. Liliya Walsh's state-law claims against Rocklin Police Department (causes of action
28	3, 4, 7, 8, 9, 10) are dismissed <i>with leave to amend.</i>
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1	13. Liliya Walsh's state-law claims against Sutter (causes of action 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 10, 11,	
2	13, 14, 15) are dismissed <i>with</i> leave to amend.	
3	14. Liliya Walsh's state-law claims against Telecare (causes of action 3, 4, 6, 7, 8 10, 11,	
4	13, 14, 15) are dismissed <i>with</i> leave to amend.	
5	15. Liliya Walsh's state-law claims against AMR (causes of action 3, 4, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11,	
6	13, 14, 15) are dismissed <i>with</i> leave to amend.
