ECF No. 209. Plaintiff states that he did mail his opposition, although the docket indicates that the court never received it. Id. at 2. I will grant plaintiff until January 2, 2024, to 23 24 file both his response to the order to show cause and either an opposition or statement of non-

orders. ECF No. 208. Plaintiff now seeks additional time to file a response to the court's order to opposition to defendants' motion for terminating sanctions.

Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that:

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- 1. Plaintiff's motion for an extension of time, ECF No. 209, is granted.
- 2. Plaintiff shall file by January 2, 2024, both his response to the court's order to show

1	cause and either an opposition or statement of non-opposition to defendants' motion for
2	terminating sanctions.
