1 Fees and expenses shall be made payable to Plaintiff, but if the Department of the Treasury 2 determines that Plaintiff does not owe a federal debt, then the government shall cause the payment of 3 fees, expenses and costs to be made directly to Bess M. Brewer, pursuant to the assignment executed by 4 Plaintiff. Any payments made shall be delivered to Plaintiff's counsel. 5 This stipulation constitutes a compromise settlement of Plaintiff's request for EAJA attorney fees 6 and expenses, and does not constitute an admission of liability on the part of Defendant under the EAJA. 7 Payment of the agreed amount shall constitute a complete release from, and bar to, any and all claims 8 that Plaintiff and/or Plaintiff's counsel may have relating to EAJA attorney fees and expenses in 9 connection with this action. 10 This award is without prejudice to the rights of Plaintiff's counsel to seek Social Security Act 11 attorney fees under 42 U.S.C. § 406, subject to the offset provisions of the EAJA. 12 13 Dated: November 17, 2014 /s/Bess M.
