FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

By order filed November 6, 2013, plaintiff was ordered to show cause why this action should not be dismissed for lack of subject matter jurisdiction. Plaintiff has not responded to the order to show cause. There is no basis of subject matter jurisdiction evident in plaintiff's pleadings.

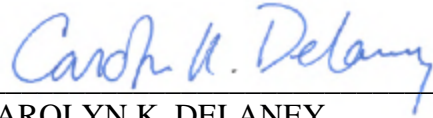
Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that this action be dismissed.
