This 21 amount represents compensation for all legal services rendered on behalf of Plaintiff, to date, by 22 counsel in connection with this civil action, in accordance with 28 U.S.C. 2412(d). 23 After the Court issues an order for EAJA fees and expenses to Plaintiff, the government 24 will consider the matter of Plaintiff's assignment of EAJA fees and expenses to Plaintiff's 25 attorney. Pursuant to Astrue v. Ratliff, 130 S. Ct. 2521 (2010), the ability to honor the 26 assignment will depend on whether the fees and expenses are subject to any offset allowed under 27 the United States Department of the Treasury's Offset Program. After the order for EAJA fees 28

1	and expenses is entered, the government will determine whether they are subject to offset.		
2	Fees and expenses shall be made payable to Plaintiff, but if the Department of the		
3	Treasury determines that Plaintiff does not owe a federal debt, then the government shall cause		
4	the payment of fees, expenses and costs to be made directly to Richard Whitaker, pursuant to the		
5	assignment executed by Plaintiff. Any payments mad	assignment executed by Plaintiff. Any payments made shall be delivered to Plaintiff's counsel.
