APPLICATION AND ORDER FOR
PUBLICATION

1 The United States of America applies for an order of publication as follows:

2 1. Rule G(4) of the Supplemental Rules for Admiralty or Maritime Claims
3 and Asset Forfeiture Actions (hereafter "Supplemental Rules") provides that the
4 Plaintiff shall cause public notice of the action to be given in a newspaper of general
5 circulation or on the official internet government forfeiture site;

6 2. Local Rule 171, Eastern District of California, provides that the Court
7 shall designate by order the appropriate newspaper or other vehicle for publication;

8 3. The defendant real properties are located in Shasta Lake and Redding,
9 California, Shasta County.

10 4. The defendants Approximately \$15,000.00 in U.S. Currency, the 2008
11 Apache Box Trailer, the 2010 Triumph Motorcycle, and the Off-Road Dune-Buggy
12 (collectively "defendant assets") were seized on September 26, 2013 in Redding, in

26 and served on the attorney for the Plaintiff no later than 60 days after the first day of
27 publication on the official internet government forfeiture site; and

28 (6) A statement that answers to the Complaint or a motion

1 under Rule 12 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure ("Fed. R. Civ. P.") must
2 be filed and served within 21 days after the filing of the claims and, in the absence
3 thereof, default may be entered and condemnation ordered.
