Petitioner has filed a petition for writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241, alleging that respondent and the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement are unlawfully detaining him at the Yuba County Jail. On February 11, 2014, the undersigned ordered respondent to file a response to the petition. Thereafter, counsel for respondent filed a motion to dismiss the petition as having been rendered moot.
