19 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED, by and between the undersigned attorneys, subject to the
20 approval of the Court, that Defendant shall have a twenty-one day extension, from August 11, 2014 to
21 September 2, 2014, in which to file her Opposition to Plaintiff's Opening Brief or otherwise respond to
22 Plaintiff's motion.

23 This request is the result of a heavy workload for counsel responsible for briefing this case. For


