The defendant Approximately \$18,731.00 in U.S. Currency ("defendant currency") was seized in the city of Shingle Springs, in El Dorado County, California. 26 Beginning on July 8, 2013, the Drug Enforcement Administration published notice of the 27 non-judicial forfeiture of the defendant currency for 30 consecutive days on the official 28

internet government forfeiture site www.forfeiture.gov. 1 4. The United States proposes that publication be made as follows: 2 One publication; a. 3 Thirty (30) consecutive days; b. 4 On the official internet government forfeiture site www.forfeiture.gov; c. 5 d. The publication is to include the following: 6 (1) The Court and case number of the action; 7 (2)The date of the seizure/posting; 8 (3) The identity and/or description of the property seized/posted; 9 The name and address of the attorney for the United States; **(4)** 10 A statement that claims of persons entitled to possession or (5)11 claiming an interest pursuant to Supplemental Rule G(5) must be filed with the Court 12 and served on the attorney for the United States no later than 60 days after the first day 13 of publication on the official internet government forfeiture site; and 14 (6)A statement that answers to the Complaint or a motion under 15 Rule 12 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure ("Fed. R. Civ.
