This is a civil action in rem brought Approximately \$10,100.00 in U.S. 18 Currency ("defendant currency"), which was seized on or about June 6, 2013. 19 20 A Verified Complaint for Forfeiture In Rem ("Complaint") was filed on November 21, 2013, alleging that said defendant currency is subject to forfeiture to the 21 22 United States pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 881(a)(6). 3. On November 25, 2013, the Clerk issued a Warrant for Arrest for the 23 defendant currency, and that warrant was duly executed on December 20, 2013. 24 4. Beginning on November 30, 2013, for at least 30 consecutive days, the 25 United States published Notice of the Forfeiture Action on the official internet 26 government forfeiture site www.forfeiture.gov. A Declaration of Publication was filed on 27 28 December 30, 2013.

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5. In addition to the public notice on the official internet government forfeiture site www.forfeiture.gov, actual notice or attempted notice was given to the following individual(s):

- Lisa Muraco a.
- Sal Sutera b.
- 6. Claimant filed a claim and answer alleging an interest in the defendant currency on January 3, 2014. No other parties have filed claims or answers in this matter, and the time in which any person or entity may file a claim and answer has expired.
- 7. The Clerk of the Court entered a Clerk's Certificate of Entry of Default against Sal Sutera on January 28, 2014. Pursuant to Local Rule 540, the United States and claimant thus join in a request that as part of the Final Judgment of Forfeiture in this case the Court enter a default judgment against the interest, if any, of Sal Sutera without further notice.

Based on the above findings, and the files and records of the Court, it is hereby ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

- 8. The Court adopts the Stipulation for Final Judgment of Forfeiture entered into by and between the parties to this action.
- 9. Judgment is hereby entered against claimant Lisa Muraco and all other potential claimants who have not filed claims in this action.
- 10. Upon entry of a Final Judgment of Forfeiture, \$6,100.00 of the \$10,100.00 in U.S. Currency, together with any interest that may have accrued on the total amount seized, shall be forfeited to the United States pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 881(a)(6), to be disposed of according to law.
- 11. Upon entry of a Final Judgment of Forfeiture herein, but no later than 60 days thereafter, \$4,000.00 of the \$10,100.00 in U.S. Currency shall be returned to claimant, through her attorney James W. Kirshner.

- 12. That the United States and its servants, agents, and employees and all other public entities, their servants, agents, and employees, are released from any and all liability arising out of or in any way connected with the seizure, arrest, or forfeiture of the defendant currency. This is a full and final release applying to all unknown and unanticipated injuries, and/or damages arising out of said seizure, arrest, or forfeiture, as well as to those now known or disclosed. The parties waived the provisions of California Civil Code § 1542.
- 13. Claimant waived any and all claim or right to interest that may have accrued on the defendant currency.
 - 14. All parties are to bear their own costs and attorneys' fees.
- 15. The U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of California, Hon. William B. Shubb, District Judge, shall retain jurisdiction to enforce the terms of this Final Judgment of Forfeiture.

CERTIFICATE OF REASONABLE CAUSE

16. Based upon the allegations set forth in the Complaint filed November 21, 2013, and the Stipulation for Final Judgment of Forfeiture filed herein, the Court enters this Certificate of Reasonable Cause pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2465, that there was reasonable cause for the seizure or arrest of the defendant currency, and for the commencement and prosecution of this forfeiture action.
