Petitioner shall submit, within thirty days from the date of this order, an affidavit in support of his request to proceed in forma pauperis or the appropriate filing fee and a habeas corpus petition on the form provided by the court; petitioner's failure to comply with this order will result in a recommendation that this action be dismissed;
