1	2. Plaintiff shall serve a copy of this order and a copy of the form "Consent to Proceed		
2	Before United States Magistrate Judge" concurrently with service of process, and file with the		
3	Clerk a certificate of such service. In addition, concurrent with service of process, plaintiff shall		
4	serve on defendants a copy of the order filed June 5, 2014 (ECF No. 17). <sup>2</sup>		
5	3. Failure to comply with the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure or Local Rules of Practice		
6	for the United States District Court, Eastern District of California, or orders of this court, may		
7	result in dismissal of this action. Even parties without counsel will be expected to comply with		
8	the procedural rules.		
9	4. A Status (Pretrial Scheduling) Conference is set for November 19, 2014 at 10:00 a.m.		
10	in courtroom no. 24 before the undersigned. All parties shall appear by counsel or in person if		
11	acting without counsel.		
12	5. Not later than fourteen (14) days prior to the Status Conference, the parties shall file		
13	status reports addressing the following matters:

19	filed fourteen days preceding the noticed hearing date. The Rule further provides that "[n]o party		
20	will be entitled to be heard in opposition to a motion at oral arguments if written opposition to the		
21	motion has not been timely filed by that party." Moreover, Local Rule 230(i) provides that		
22	failure to appear may be deemed withdrawal of opposition to the motion or may result in		
23	sanctions. Finally, Local Rule 110 provides that failure to comply with the Local Rules "may be		
24	grounds for imposition of any and all sanctions authorized by statute or Rule or within the		
25	inherent power of the Court."		
26	7. The parties are informed that they may, if all consent, have this case tried by a United		
27	States Magistrate Judge while preserving their right to appeal to the Ninth Circuit Court of		
28	Appeals. See 28 U.S.C. § 636(c). The form for consent to trial by a magistrate judge is attached.		

1	Any party choosing to consent may complete the form and return it to the Clerk of the Court.		
2	8. The Clerk of the Court is directed to send plaintiff copies (one for each defendant plus		
3	one for the plaintiff) of the form, "Consent to Proceed Before United States Magistrate Judge,"		
4	with this order.
