ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Plaintiff is proceeding in this action pro se. In the complaint, plaintiff complains about an allegedly wrongful foreclosure. Plaintiff alleges only state law claims. The complaint does not allege a basis for subject matter jurisdiction in this court. The federal courts are courts of limited jurisdiction. In the absence of a basis for federal jurisdiction, plaintiff's claims cannot proceed in this venue. Because there is no basis for federal subject matter jurisdiction evident in the complaint, plaintiff will be ordered to show cause why this action should not be dismissed. Failure to allege a proper basis for subject matter jurisdiction will result in a recommendation that the action be dismissed.
