On or about March 11, 2013, claimant Fred Fry filed a claim in the 21 administrative forfeiture proceeding with the Drug Enforcement Administration with 22 respect to the Approximately \$19,880.00 in U.S. Currency (hereafter "defendant 23 currency"), which was seized on January 16, 2013. 24 25 2. The Drug Enforcement Administration has sent the written notice of intent to forfeit required by 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(1)(A) to all known interested parties. 26 The time has expired for any person to file a claim to the defendant currency under 18 27

U.S.C. § 983(a)(2)(A)-(E), and no person other than claimant has filed a claim to the

defendant currency as required by law in the administrative forfeiture proceeding.

- 3. Under 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(3)(A), the United States is required to file a complaint for forfeiture against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is subject to forfeiture within ninety days after a claim has been filed in the administrative forfeiture proceeding, unless the court extends the deadline for good cause shown or by agreement of the parties. That deadline is June 7, 2013.
- 4. As provided in 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(3)(A), the parties wish by agreement to extend to August 6, 2013, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for forfeiture against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is subject to forfeiture.
- 5. Accordingly, the parties agree that the deadline by which the United States shall be required to file a complaint for forfeiture against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is subject to forfeiture shall be extended to August 6, 2013.
