IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

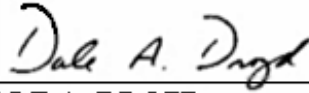
1. Within 14 days after this order is filed, petitioner shall serve his petition and a copy of this order upon each respondent identified in the caption of the petition and shall file a certificate of such service within 7 days after service is made.
2. Within 28 days after the petition is served by petitioner, respondents shall file and serve a response to the petition.
3. If respondents' response to the petition is an answer, a reply shall be filed by petitioner within 14 days after the response is filed. Any party may request oral argument by

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1 including the request in the answer or reply. If no request for oral argument is made, the petition
2 to quash will be submitted on the papers upon the completion of briefing.

3 4. If respondents' response to the petition is a motion, the motion shall be noticed
4 for hearing before the undersigned on a regularly scheduled law and motion calendar and shall be
5 briefed and heard in accordance with Local Rule 230.
