**ORDER DENYING DEFENDANT'S  
COUNSEL'S MOTION TO WITHDRAW AS  
COUNSEL**

14 Kronick Moskovitz Tiedermann & Girard ("KMTG") moves  
15 under Local Rule 182<sup>1</sup> for "an order permitting KMTG to withdraw  
16 as counsel of record for [D]efendant Thomason Law Center  
17 ("Thomason")," a professional corporation. (Notice of Motion  
18 1:23-24, ECF No. 23.)

19 Local Rule 182(d) prescribes: "Withdrawal as attorney  
20 is governed by the Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar  
21 of California, and the attorney shall conform to the requirements  
22 of those Rules." California Rule of Professional Conduct 3-  
23 700(A)(2) prescribes: "A[n] [attorney] shall not withdraw from  
24 employment until the [attorney] has taken reasonable steps to  
25 avoid reasonably foreseeable prejudice to the rights of the  
26 client . . . ." Here, it is unclear whether KMTG has explained

27 <sup>1</sup> Counsel states it moves "pursuant to Local Rule 183" (Notice of Motion  
28 1:23), however, that rule governs pro se plaintiffs. Local Rule 182 governs  
counsel's motion since it concerns attorney appearances and withdrawal.

1 to its client that if KMTG's withdrawal motion is granted,  
2 Defendant cannot litigate this case in federal court because a  
3 corporation must be represented by an attorney. See E.D. Cal.  
4 L.R. 183(a) ("A corporation or other entity may appear only by an  
5 attorney.").

6 Further, Local Rule 182(d) prescribes an attorney  
7 seeking to withdraw as counsel "shall provide an affidavit  
8 stating the current or last known address or addresses of the  
9 client." KMTG has not submitted a separate affidavit stating the  
10 current or last known address of Defendant.

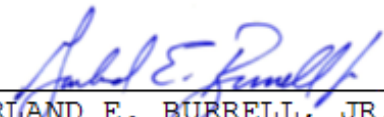
11 For the stated reasons, KMTG's motion for withdrawal as
