ORDER


Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding pro se with this civil rights action. Pending before the court is plaintiff's motion to compel. Defendants Lee, Rohlfing, and Swingle have opposed the motion as untimely.

Under the court's discovery and scheduling order, the parties were required to complete discovery and file any motions to compel on or before March 13, 2015. Plaintiff's motion to compel filed on June 11, 2015, is therefore untimely.
