ORDER

The court is in receipt of a motion styled as “Plaintiff Ken Hamidi’s motion to quash third party subpoena *duces tecum*.” Although plaintiff Hamidi is represented by counsel in this action, the motion was filed by plaintiff Hamidi himself acting *pro se*. Ordinarily, the court would be concerned about a represented party attempting to file documents himself *pro se*, and would have been disinclined to even permit such filings on the case docket. However, upon closer examination, it appears that plaintiff Hamidi did not file the motion on his own behalf as a plaintiff in the case, but instead has moved to quash a subpoena directed to a non-party corporation, the California Professional Public Employees Association (“CPPEA”), with which plaintiff Hamidi is somehow involved.
