17 Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed this civil rights action seeking relief
18 under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to
19 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.


20 On May 12, 2015, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein which
21 were served on all parties and which contained notice to all parties that any objections to the
22 findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. Neither party has filed
23 objections to the findings and recommendations.

24 The court has reviewed the file and finds the findings and recommendations to be
25 supported by the record and by the magistrate judge's analysis. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY
26 ORDERED that:

- 27 1. The findings and recommendations filed May 12, 2015, are adopted in full; and
28 2. Plaintiff's motion for summary judgment (ECF No. 42) is denied; and

1 3. Defendants' summary judgment motion (ECF No. 48) is denied as to plaintiff's
2 excessive force claim against defendants in their individual capacities for damages, and denied as
3 to plaintiff's request for punitive damages and for mental and emotional injuries; defendants'
4 summary judgment is granted in all other respects.
