7	Election to Decline Intervention, which relators will serve upon defendant only after service of
8	the complaint;
9	3. The seal be lifted as to all other matters occurring in this action after the date of this
10	Order;
11	4. The parties shall serve all pleadings and motions filed in this action, including supporting
12	memoranda, upon the United States, as provided for in 31 U.S.C. § 3730(c)(3). The United
13	States may order any deposition transcripts and is entitled to intervene in this action, for good
14	cause, at any time;
15	5. The parties shall serve all notices of appeal upon the United States;
16	6. All orders of this Court shall be sent to the United States; and that
17	7. Should relators or defendant propose that this action be dismissed, settled, or otherwise
18	discontinued, the Court will provide the United States with notice and an opportunity to be heard
19	before ruling or granting its approval.
