FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Plaintiff is a state prisoner, proceeding without counsel, with a civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The undersigned has separately issued an order addressing the complaint filed February 12, 2014. In this order, the undersigned found that plaintiff's claims against defendants University of California Regents and University of California Davis Medical Center are barred by the Eleventh Amendment. For the reasons stated in that order, the undersigned now recommends dismissal of these defendants.

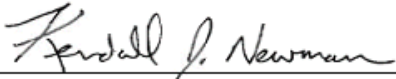
Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that defendants University of California Regents and University of California Davis Medical Center be dismissed.

These findings and recommendations are submitted to the United States District Judge assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1). Within fourteen days after being served with these findings and recommendations, plaintiff may file written objections with the court and serve a copy on all parties. Such a document should be captioned

2 failure to file objections within the specified time may waive the right to appeal the District
3 Court’s order. Martinez v. Ylst, 951 F.2d 1153 (9th Cir. 1991).
