Plaintiff's Motion for Clarification of Injunction
(Docket No. 122) is DENIED. As the court pointed out in its
Order of September 30, 2015 (Docket No 85), the court's Order of
July 14, 2015 (Docket No. 60) granted plaintiff exactly the
relief it requested. (Docket No. 85) Neither of those orders
needs clarification.

This is not what the court contemplated when it denied

1 plaintiff's contempt motion "without prejudice to plaintiff
2 making a more specific request for relief." (Docket No 117). If
3 plaintiff wishes to request another injunction, specifically
4 enjoining other conduct, it shall do so with a noticed motion in
5 compliance with the applicable rules.
