

1 motion on January 3, 2017.¹ In light of plaintiff's representations and pro se status, the order to
2 show cause is discharged and the hearing on Wells Fargo's motion will be continued to allow
3 plaintiff an opportunity to file an opposition.

4 Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that:

5 1. The hearing on defendant's motion for judgment on the pleadings (ECF No. 50) is
6 continued to February 15, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. in Courtroom No. 8.

7 2. Plaintiff shall file an opposition to the motion, or a statement of non-opposition thereto,
8 no later than February 1, 2017.

9 3. Failure to file an opposition to the motion will be deemed a statement of non-
10 opposition thereto, and may result in a recommendation that this action be dismissed for lack of
11 prosecution and/or for failure to comply with court orders and this court's Local Rules. *See Fed.*
12 *R. Civ. P. 41(b).*

13 4. Defendant may file a reply to plaintiff's opposition, if any, on or before February 8,
14 2017.

15 5. The December 15, 2016 order to show cause is discharged and no sanctions are
16 imposed.
