The Appeals Council will instruct the ALJ to reassess the credibility of Plaintiff's

1	subjective complaints consistent with the applicable regulations, Social Security Rulings, and	
2	Ninth Circuit case law.	
3	The Appeals Council will also instruct the ALJ to reassess Plaintiff's residual functional	
4	capacity, and determine whether Plaintiff could perform any other work existing in significant	
5	numbers in the national economy given his age, education, vocational factors, and residual	
6	functional capacity.	
7	The parties' further request the Clerk of the Court be directed to enter a final judgment in	
8	favor of Plaintiff, and against Defendant, reversing the final decision of the Commissioner.
