



1 A review of the bankruptcy docket in adversary proceeding 2:13-ap-2261 indicates  
2 that the underlying action is ongoing.<sup>3</sup> Pursuant to Local Rule 145(b), this matter is  
3 PARTIALLY REMANDED to the Bankruptcy Court for a recommendation concerning the  
4 finality of the judgment(s), order(s) or decree(s) from which Appellant Patrick Fagundes  
5 seeks relief. See ECF Nos. 124, 138, Case No. 2:13-ap-2261. If the Bankruptcy Court  
6 advises the District Court that the judgment, order or decree is not final but interlocutory,  
7 the Bankruptcy Court shall make a recommendation to the District Court whether leave  
8 to appeal should be granted. See E.D. Cal. Local Rules 145.

9 As set forth above, this matter is PARTIALLY REMANDED to the Bankruptcy  
10 Court. The Clerk of the Court SHALL SERVE a copy of this order on the United States  
11 Bankruptcy Court, Eastern District of California, for filing on the docket for adversarial  
12 proceeding Patrick Fagundes v. JPMorgan Chase, et. al., Case No. 2:13-ap-2261.
