See ECF No. 16. Thereafter, plaintiff filed 19 two matters which the court construes as a request for extension of time within which to file a 20 Second Amended Complaint. See ECF Nos. 17, 18. The request will be granted. 21 In addition to granting plaintiff extended time, the court has reviewed plaintiff's concerns 22 in light of his several recent transfers among prisons, and finds it appropriate to request that the 23 Office of the California Attorney General inquire as the current location of all plaintiff's personal 24 property. Plaintiff's various exhibits indicate that, since 2012, he has been incarcerated at 25 California State Prison-Sacramento (CSP-SAC), Kern Valley State Prison, the California Medical 26 Facility, and then again at CSP-SAC; and that plaintiff's property has routinely lagged behind. 27 See e.g., ECF No. 18 at 3; see generally the filings in this case; see also Dahl v. Virga et al., Case 28 No. 2:13-cv-02313-CMK, ECF Nos. 15-6. The Office of the Attorney General is requested to 1
