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 25 The United States of America applies for an order of publication as follows:

26 1. Rule G(4) of the Supplemental Rules for Admiralty or Maritime Claims and
 27 Asset Forfeiture Actions (hereafter "Supplemental Rules") provides that the United States
 28 shall cause public notice of the action to be given in a newspaper of general circulation or

1 on the official internet government forfeiture site;

2 2. Local Rule 171, Eastern District of California, provides that the Court shall
3 designate by order the appropriate newspaper or other vehicle for publication;

4 3. The defendant Approximately \$538,155.00 seized from ING Direct Checking
5 Account # 156773818 was seized in the city of Wilmington, in New Castle County,
6 Delaware. The defendants 2011 Ferrari California Convertible, VIN: ZFF65 LJA0B 01766
7 22, New Jersey License Plate: NOTOUCH; 2011 Audi A5 Convertible, VIN:
8 WAULFAFH9BN009524, New Jersey License Plate: W98ARP; 2013 Blue Porsche Panamera,
9 VIN: WPOAB2A71DL060573, New Jersey License Plate: 2012ROJ; and Approximately \$10,002.00
10 in U.S. Currency were seized in the city of Marlboro, in Monmouth County, New Jersey;

11 4. The United States proposes that publication be made as follows:

12 a. One publication;

13 b. Thirty (30) consecutive days;

14 c. On the official internet government forfeiture site www.forfeiture.gov;

15 d. The publication is to include the following:

16 (1) The Court and case number of the action;

17 (2) The date of the seizure/posting;

18 (3) The identity and/or description of the property seized/posted;

19 (4) The name and address of the attorney for the United States;

20 (5) A statement that claims of persons entitled to possession or
21 claiming an interest pursuant to Supplemental Rule G(5) must be filed with the Court and
22 served on the attorney for the United States no later than 60 days after the first day of
23 publication on the official internet government forfeiture site; and

24 (6) A statement that answers to the Complaint or a motion under
25 Rule 12 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure ("Fed. R. Civ. P.") must be filed and served

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1 within 21 days after the filing of the claims and, in the absence thereof, default may be
2 entered and condemnation ordered.
