ORDER REGARDING CLERK'S
ISSUANCE OF WARRANT FOR
ARREST OF ARTICLES *IN REM*

18 WHEREAS, a Verified Complaint for Forfeiture *In Rem* has been filed on June 9,
19 2014 in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of California, alleging that
20 the defendant Approximately \$88,340.00 in U.S. Currency and Approximately \$70,240.00
21 in U.S. Currency (collectively "Defendant Currency") is subject to forfeiture to the United
22 States pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 881(a)(6) for one or more violations of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841 *et*
23 *seq.*;

24 And, the Court being satisfied that, based on the Verified Complaint for Forfeiture
25 *In Rem* and the affidavit of Drug Enforcement Administration Task Force Officer Agent
26 Steve Maes, there is probable cause to believe that the Defendant Currency so described
27 constitutes property that is subject to forfeiture for such violation(s), and that grounds for
28 the issuance of a Warrant for Arrest of Articles *In Rem* exist, pursuant to Rule G(3)(b)(i)

1 of the Supplemental Rules for Admiralty or Maritime Claims and Asset Forfeiture
2 Actions;

3 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Clerk for the United States District Court,
4 Eastern District of California, shall issue a Warrant for Arrest of Articles *In Rem* for the
5 Defendant Currency.
