ECF No. 1. When the action was filed, only David Swanson 21 filed a request to proceed in forma pauperis. The court denied the request because Swanson-22 Houston had not sought to proceed in forma pauperis. ECF No. 3. Both plaintiffs have now 23 submitted requests to proceed in forma pauperis. ECF Nos. 7 & 8. As both qualify to proceed 24 without prepayment of fees, the court grants both requests and allows the action to proceed 25 without payment of the filing fee. 26 In addition, Swanson-Houston has applied to act as guardian ad litem for Swanson, 27 who is an incompetent adult. Under Rule 17(c)(2) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the
