questions about whether some of the other information on the form could also possibly relate to Mr. Mezquita as opposed to Mr. Pannell. Second, the court notes that the answer to question five is incomplete, because although it states that plaintiff owns property, the answer fails to describe the property and estimate its value. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. Plaintiff's application to proceed in forma pauperis (ECF No. 2) is denied without prejudice. 2. Within 28 days of this order, plaintiff shall either submit a properly completed amended application to proceed in forma pauperis addressing the above deficiencies, or pay the applicable filing fee. 3. Plaintiff's failure to file an amended application or pay the filing fee by the required deadline may result in dismissal of the action pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b).
