17	Petitioner, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed an application for a writ of habeas	
18	corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254, together with a request to proceed in forma pauperis	
19	pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915.	
20	Review of the petitioner's in forma pauperis affidavit indicates that it is incomplete.	
21	Specifically, petitioner did not answer all of the questions, nor did he sign and date the affidavit,

The Clerk of the Court is directed to send petitioner, together with a copy of this order, a new Application to Proceed In Forma Pauperis By a Prisoner. 3. Petitioner shall, within thirty days after the filing date of this order, complete and sign the in forma pauperis application and file it in this court together with a certified copy of his prison trust account statement for the six-month period immediately preceding the commencement of this action. 4.
