17	The parties and counsel met in settlement conference today before the undersigned. The	
18	parties agreed to explore a process which might lead to settlement of this case. However, this	
19	potential process requires some investigation into the logistics of such a process. In order to	
20	facilitate this investigation, the parties agreed to suspend litigation activity with the possible	
21	exception of the presently filed motion for protective order. (That motion was rescheduled to be	
22	heard on March 27, 2015 before the undersig	ned conferred with Judge Drozd).
23	The suspension of litigation activity shall expire in sixty (60) days from the date of this	
24	order. In order to accommodate this suspension, Judge England has determined to extend the	
25	current discovery cutoff by ninety (90) days, and has issued a minute order to that effect. If the	
26	parties agree, the presently scheduled motion for protective order may be vacated without	
27	prejudice to its refiling. In the event that no agreement is reached concerning vacating of the	
28	motion, it shall be heard on March 27 and the	e parties shall file their Joint Statement in accordance

1	with the Local Rules. No other litigation activity is contemplated during the 60 day suspension	
2	period.	
3	At any time during this 60 day period, the parties may contact the undersigned for further	
4	settlement conference scheduling. In the event that the settlement process discussed above is not	
5	feasible, litigation activity may resume without further order of the court at the expiration of the	
6	sixty day period.	
7	If no contact with the undersigned is made for further settlement conference, the parties	
8	shall file a concise statement reporting on the status of the potential settlement process at the	
9	expiration of the 60 day period.
