court will not rule on petitioner's in forma pauperis application. Pursuant to Local Rule 190(d), the above-captioned action will be reassigned to the Magistrate Judge² who is considering the prior petition. The parties should be aware that reassigning this action under Local Rule 190(d) merely has the result that the action is assigned to the Magistrate Judge who is considering or has considered the prior petition; no consolidation of the actions is effected. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. The Clerk of the Court is directed to substitute the name of Kim Holland, Warden, as respondent in the docket of this case. 2. This action is reassigned to Magistrate Judge Edmund F. Brennan for all further proceedings; henceforth, the caption on documents filed in this action shall be shown as No. 2:14-1691 EFB; and 3. The Clerk of the Court shall make appropriate adjustment in the assignment of civil cases to compensate for this reassignment. DATED: August 27, 2014 UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE
