

1	and the state court action is titled as such. Defendant has failed to meet his burden of establishing
2	federal jurisdiction and the matter should therefore be remanded. See generally Singer v. State
3	Farm Mutual Automobile Insurance Co., 116 F.3d 373, 375-376 (9th Cir. 1997).
4	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that the above-entitled action be
5	summarily remanded to the Superior Court of California, County of Sacramento.
6	These findings and recommendations are submitted to the United States District Judge
7	assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1). Within fourteen days
8	after being served with these findings and recommendations, any party may file written
9	objections with the court and serve a copy on all parties. Such a document should be captioned
10	"Objections to Magistrate Judge's Findings and Recommendations." Any reply to the objections
11	shall be served and filed within seven days after service of the objections. The parties are advised
12	that failure to file objections within the specified time may waive the right to appeal the District
13	Court's order. Martinez v. Ylst, 951 F.2d 1153 (9th Cir. 1991).
