ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Plaintiffs are proceeding in this action pro se. Plaintiffs have filed a forty-one page complaint that is vague and ambiguous as to what claims plaintiffs are making. The complaint does not allege a basis for subject matter jurisdiction in this court. The federal courts are courts of limited jurisdiction. In the absence of a basis for federal jurisdiction, plaintiffs' claims cannot proceed in this venue. Because there is no basis for federal subject matter jurisdiction evident in the complaint, plaintiffs will be ordered to show cause why this action should not be dismissed. Failure to allege a proper basis for subject matter jurisdiction will result in a recommendation that the action be dismissed.
