39 **CHANGING SCHEDULING**  
40 **CONFERENCE AND JOINT**

1 Plaintiff Safari Club International (“Safari Club”) and Defendants Attorney General  
2 Kamala D. Harris and Director Charlton H. Bonham (“Defendants,” and collectively with Safari  
3 Club, the “Parties”), by and through their respective counsel, jointly submit for approval this  
4 stipulation regarding the rescheduling of the pretrial scheduling conference (currently set for  
5 April 20, 2015) and joint status report (currently due April 4, 2015). In support, the Parties state  
6 the following:

7 WHEREAS, on August 6, 2014, Safari Club filed its Complaint for Declaratory and  
8 Injunctive Relief.

9 WHEREAS on October 6, 2014, Defendants filed a Motion to Dismiss Safari Club’s  
10 Complaint, originally noticed for hearing on November 17, 2014;

11 WHEREAS by stipulation of the parties and Orders of this Court, the hearing date was  
12 ultimately rescheduled for April 20, 2015;

13 WHEREAS by an Order dated October 17, 2014 (Dkt. 17), the Court scheduled a pretrial  
14 scheduling conference for April 20, 2015, approximately 10 weeks after the then-current date for  
15 the hearing on the motion to dismiss (February 2), and ordered the parties to file a joint status  
16 report 14 days prior to the scheduling conference.

17 WHEREAS, due to the pending motion to dismiss Safari Club’s complaint, the Parties  
18 believe that the preparation of a joint status report by April 6, 2015, and holding of a pretrial  
19 scheduling conference on April 20, 2015, are premature and, in the interests of efficiency and  
20 conservation of judicial and party resources, should be postponed until after the Court has  
21 resolved the motion to dismiss.

1 WHEREAS, the Court previously set the pretrial scheduling conference for  
2 approximately 10 weeks after the hearing on the motion to dismiss, the Parties suggest a new  
3 pretrial scheduling conference be scheduled for June 29, 2015, and the joint status report be due  
4 14 days prior to this date;

5 THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the Parties respectfully request approval  
6 of this stipulation to grant the following relief:

7 The preparation of the joint status report be rescheduled to June 15, 2015, and the April  
8 20, 2015 pretrial scheduling conference be rescheduled to June 29, 2015, or the earliest date  
9 thereafter that is convenient for the Court.


