25	Examination of the above-entitled actions reveals that these	
26	actions are related within the meaning of Local Rule 123 (E.D. Cal.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court make 17 appropriate adjustment in the assignment of civil cases to 18 compensate for this reassignment.
