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1 Plaintiff Karin Bjork's ("Bjork") two Motions to Compel Documents [Dkt. 49 and 50] and
2 Defendants Motion to Quash the deposition subpoena of investigator Teresa Levenfeld [Dkt. 54]
3 came on for hearing on Wednesday July 20, 2016. Jill P. Telfer appeared on behalf of Plaintiff
4 Karin Bjork. David K. Huskey appeared on behalf of Defendant County of Placer District
5 Attorney's Office.

6 After review of the papers and arguments made by counsel, the Court granted Plaintiff's
7 Motion to Compel Document Request 4, 6, 8, 15, 18, 22 and 24 with the following conditions:
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9 1. Plaintiff shall amend document request No. 15, 22, and 24 to be more narrowly tailored
10 as described at the hearing.

11 2. Third parties whose documents are being produced in response to Document Request
12 No. 15 shall have 7 days to object to the production of documents. Said objection must be
13 electronically filed with the Court.

14 3. Counsel for the Defendant shall immediately notify third parties whose records are being
15 requested, under Document Request No. 15 and inform them of their right to object to document
16 request within seven days.

17 4. As to documents requested concerning third party Rich Opich, the Defendant is only
18 required to produce documents concerning any performance concerns about Rich Opich over the
19 last 10 years of his employment. However, if Defendant plans to raise issues regarding Rich
20 Opich's performance from an earlier time frame, it must immediately turn over any responsive
21 documents from the earlier time frame.
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23 As to these three discovery motions, the parties are reminded that if there is a need to
24 modify the protective order, the parties may do so and submit a proposed order to the Court.
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IT IS SO ORDERED.
