 17 TO THE U.S. MARSHALS SERVICE AND/OR ANY OTHER DULY AUTHORIZED  
 18 LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER:

19 WHEREAS, a verified complaint of forfeiture has been filed on September 4, 2014, in  
 20 the United States District Court for the Eastern District of California, alleging that the  
 21 defendant Approximately \$11,800.00 in U.S. Currency (“Defendant Currency”) is subject to  
 22 forfeiture to the United States pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 881(a)(6) for one or more violations  
 23 of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841 *et seq.*;

24 WHEREAS, Rule G(3)(b)(i) of the Supplemental Rules for Admiralty or Maritime  
 25 Claims and Asset Forfeiture Actions (“Supplemental Rules”) provides that when the  
 26 United States files a complaint demanding a forfeiture for violation of a federal statute,  
 27 the clerk must issue a warrant to arrest the property if it is in the government’s  
 28 possession, custody, or control. The Defendant Currency is in the custody of the U.S.

1 Postal Inspection Service, San Francisco Division;

2 WHEREAS, in addition, United States Magistrate Judge Kendall J. Newman has  
3 ordered that the Clerk for the United States District Court, Eastern District of California,  
4 shall issue a Warrant for Arrest of Articles *In Rem* for the Defendant Currency based on  
5 the Verified Complaint for Forfeiture *In Rem* and the affidavit of United States Postal  
6 Inspector Michael Chavez, stating that there is probable cause to believe that the  
7 Defendant Currency so described constitutes property that is subject to forfeiture for such  
8 violation(s);


9 YOU ARE, THEREFORE, HEREBY COMMANDED to arrest and seize the  
10 Defendant Currency, and use discretion and whatever means appropriate to protect and  
11 maintain said Defendant Currency; and

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that you shall provide notice of this action to all  
13 persons thought to have an interest in or claim against the Defendant Currency by  
14 serving upon such persons a copy of this warrant and a copy of the Verified Complaint for  
15 Forfeiture *In Rem* in a manner consistent with the Supplemental Rules, the Federal  
16 Rules of Civil Procedure ("Fed. R. Civ. P."), and federal law. This warrant provides notice  
17 that in order to avoid forfeiture of the Defendant Currency, any person claiming an  
18 interest in, or right against, the property must file a verified claim, signed under penalty  
19 of perjury, identifying the interest in, or right against, the property in the manner set  
20 forth in Rule G(5)(a) of the Supplemental Rules, Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, except  
21 that in no event may such claim be filed later than 35 days after the date of notice of the  
22 forfeiture action and a copy of the complaint was sent or, as applicable, 60 days after the  
23 first day of publication on the official internet government forfeiture site  
24 [www.forfeiture.gov](http://www.forfeiture.gov) posting the notice of the forfeiture action. In addition, any person  
25 having filed such a claim must also file an answer to the complaint or a motion under  
26 Rule G(5) and Fed. R. Civ. P., Rule 12 no later than 21 days after the filing of the claim,  
27 with a copy thereof sent to Assistant U.S. Attorney Jeffrey A. Spivak, 501 I Street, Suite  
28 10-100, Sacramento, CA 95814.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, promptly after execution of this process, you shall  
2 file the same in this Court with your return thereon, identifying the individuals upon  
3 whom copies were served and the manner employed.
